

Grouped Under Themes: Incorporate cognitive impairment and disability rights/anti-ableism framework in all projects moving forward. Topics in order of membership votes received.

1. Continuum of Care + Improving coordination of services & supports + Supportive Services:

- a guide for long-term services and supports, advancing supportive models of care, improving community-based care options, addressing the needs of people with cognitive impairment;
- better coordination amongst healthcare providers, particularly for underrepresented communities¹;
- Affordable healthcare complemented by services that support systemically underrepresented communities overall well-being and quality of life;
- Support people to be able to negotiate the barriers and confidently voice the challenges
- Advancing supportive models of care for homeless adults with mental health challenges transitioning into housing;
- Building out better community-based care options for complexly diagnosed adults that do not require rehousing/relocation (advancing "aging in place" systems); and
- Advocate for and "watchdog" cross-agency cooperation on all LTC topics.

2. Social Isolation/Connectedness:

- Addressing the digital divide, particularly consumer's access to telehealth and other vital services. For example, ensure internet access (service and technology) on a needs-basis to any recipient;
- Acknowledge its impact on general health
- Review existing efforts and recommendations (such as LTCCC workgroup)
