With CalFresh, you will receive an EBT card that you can use just like a debit card to buy fresh, healthy food all over the city at places like grocery stores, farmers’ markets, and even online for home delivery.

CalFresh Feeds San Francisco

- If you are eligible based on your income, you can qualify for CalFresh. The amount you receive depends on your household size, income and other benefits like unemployment. Families of four can receive up to \$939 a month!
- CalFresh is more than food. You’ll also be eligible for employment opportunities, education, and job skills. CalFresh recipients can also receive free diapers and discounts on utilities. Learn more at SFHSA.org/discounts

Support for Immigrant Families

- Nearly all individuals who qualify for CalFresh are currently not affected by public charge rules.
