Family First [FFPSA] Implementation in San Francisco

Families sometimes need extra support to navigate through crises.

- FFPSA provides that support by enabling Family Resource Centers to connect these families with the appropriate, community-based services.
- Participants can also benefit from substance use, mental health, and parenting services offered by the FRC network.
- Participation is voluntary and designed to empower families to determine and meet their family goals.



Connect

Family Resource Centers (FRCs) connect with families in crisis who need help with navigating the support services system.



Engage

FRC team collects family information and helps identify the services that the family wants.



Assess and Plan

FRC completes a comprehensive needs assessment and partners with the family to create a goal plan.



Refer

FRC refers the family to the appropriate community-based services for their goal plan.



Meet and Sustain Goals

Community-based services help family meet and sustain their goals to improve family functioning, which creates healthier communities.
